Novice: A and Rep B Head Coach

Trained status is required for the position of **Head Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Coach 1 (1 day in class course)
- Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

The Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course must be completed before the coach can register for the Coach 1 in class course.

Novice A and Rep B Assistant Coach:

Trained status is required for the position of **Assistant Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Coach 1 (1 day in class course)
- Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

The Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course and the Gender Identity Training must be completed before the coach can register for the Coach 1 in class course.

Novice A or Rep B Trainer:

Certified status is required for the position of **Trainer**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- HTCP Level 1 - Online Certification
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Novice A or Rep B Manager:

- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Atom A, AA, or Rep B Head Coach:

Trained status is required for the position of **Head Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Coach 2 (1 day in class course)
- Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders

Atom A, AA or Rep B Assistant Coach:

- Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

The Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course must be completed before the coach can register for the Coach 2 in class course.

Atom A, AA or Rep B Trainer:

Certified status is required for the position of **Trainer**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- HTCP Level 1 - Online Certification
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam or Midget A, AA, or Rep B Head Coach

Trained status is required for the position of **Peewee A Head Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Development 1 (2 day in class course)
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Complete and pass a take home assignment within 30 days of completion of the in class course
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam Midget A, AA, or Rep B: Assistant Coach

Trained status is required for the position of **Assistant Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Development 1 (2 day in class course)
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Complete and pass a take home assignment within 30 days of completion of the in class course
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam or Midget A, AA, or Rep B Trainer

Certified status is required for the position of **Trainer**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- HTCP Level 1 - Online Certification
- Standard First Aid or higher for HTCP Level 2 status
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam or Midget A, AA, or Rep B Manager

- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam or Midget AAA Head Coach:

Certified status is required for the position of **Head Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Development 1 (2 day in class course)
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Making Ethical Decisions (Competition-Development) - online evaluation at www.coach.ca
- Complete and pass a take home assignment within 30 days of completion of the in class course
- Pass a field assessment of a practice
- Gender Identity Online Training

Coaches that completed their Development 1 course prior to 2013 are not required to have a field assessment conducted.

Peewee, Bantam or Midget AAA Assistant Coach:

Certified status is required for the position of **Assistant Coach**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Development 1 (2 day in class course)
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Making Ethical Decisions (Competition-Development) - online evaluation at www.coach.ca
- Complete and pass a take home assignment within 30 days of completion of the in class course
- Pass a field assessment of a practice

Certification requirements

Competitive

- Gender Identity Online Training

Coaches that completed their Development 1 course prior to 2013 are not required to have a field assessment conducted.

Peewee, Bantam or Midget AAA Trainer

Certified status is required for the position of **Trainer**.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- HTCP Level 1 - Online Certification
- Standard First Aid or higher for HTCP Level 2 status
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

Peewee, Bantam or Midget AAA Manager

- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training
