Trained status is required for the position of Novice House League Head Coach.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Coach 1 (1 day in class course)
- Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
- Gender Identity Online Training

The Hockey University Online Coach 1/2 course must be completed before the coach can register for the Coach 1 in class course.

Trained status is required for the position of Novice House League Assistant Coach.

To achieve this status you must complete the following components:

- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders

Assistant Coaches at House League require Respect in Sport (RIS)-Activity Leader only.
